The Festival caters for darts players of all standards, both male and female, and their family and friends who may wish to come along just as supporters to enjoy all that Barbados is justly famous for and to join in the varied list of optional excursions and activities.

The social darts events take place at a The Sporting Pig in St Lawrence Gap, a short walk from your hotel, and the major tournaments, with cash prizes, will be staged at the well appointed, air conditioned Solidarity House over the weekend of November 10 - 12. Participants will be transported to and from here by bus.

The Festival Director wants to ensure that it retains the character that has made it so popular – namely a Darts Festival that caters for all, rather than a darts tournament dominated by the few. It is about enjoying all that Barbados has to offer and meeting new friends in darts rather than focusing entirely on winning tournaments.



Your accommodation in the popular St Lawrence Gap is just yards away from, on one side, the clear, warm, azure blue ocean and, on the other, a host of restaurants, bars, night clubs, and shops – all within easy walking distance.

Hotel rooms to suit all tastes and budgets in our HQ hotels are available from c.£40 per person per night (2 sharing) with one option to include continental breakfast and taxes. The fee for full participation in all the events at the Festival is £80 per person and £40 per person as social members.

HOW TO JOIN US:

Simply advise the Festival Director of your interest and he will provide you with more information and advice. Then book a return flight to Barbados to take in the period of the Festival – arriving earlier or staying later if you so wish. The key to getting good bargains on flights is to book early. Thomas Cook has return flights out of Manchester on Nov 2 & Nov 5 for c.£450. BA & Virgin operate daily flights from Gatwick.

With your flights booked contact The Festival Director with your choice of HQ hotel and type of room you require and the Festival Director will organise this.

Conditions For Entry to the Festival are that participants must book their hotel accommodation through the Festival Director and pay a registration fee of £80 per person for full participation and £40 for social participation at least one month prior to the Festival. All matters relating to the organisation and participation in the Barbados Darts Festival remain at the discretion of The Festival Director.
